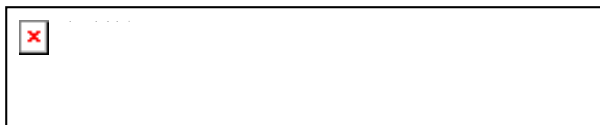

I think we can still work with NSW and Namoi Water to go through all the views and check with facts, from which we can make an informed decision on acceptance of this rule change.

Initial comments from [s.47F] on the 50:50 supp rule change - suggest that under the rule there will be an increase in take, but that might be ok within the current WSP limits (I am just checking a fact with him). However, NSW can put in place other arrangements to ensure there is no growth in use here going forward. I will need to talk to Mike Makin about that.

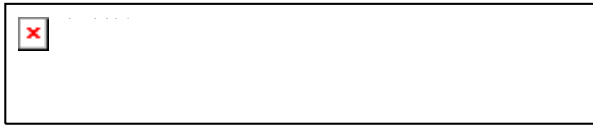
