Hi Phillip,

I realise I will be seeing you this evening but as a reminder to myself and to include others:

I had the opportunity to talk with the Exec Officers of the NSW northern irrigator groups yesterday and apart from the usual concerns around visibility and things not coming together quickly enough, there was a specific request as to whether MDBA could provide an update (at say end of March) on *held entitlement* by northern catchments, i.e. State and Cth holdings that are already secured (not contracted).

There is ongoing concern that NSW might not be done & dusted (particularly in Namoi and BR). I think the question is valid, given some changes to State Priority Projects that have occurred along the way, as well as being something that we should be able to answer. I note our current reporting (<http://www.mdba.gov.au/sites/default/files/docs/Environmental-Water-Recovery-Esimates-31-March-2016-Detailed.pdf>) is based on yield, and that only causes the cap factor issue to resurface for these guys, so perhaps we can get the entitlement holdings underpinning this table to them?

Will chat further tonight anyway.
